





- Maintain good study habits & effective time-management skills


Taking honors-level classes can help the student build foundational skills and knowledge for the rigor of IB classes in junior and senior year





- But because the student did well in 9th grade, it allows the OVERALL GPA to be a 3.162!

Community Service

Community Service

- **NOT** a requirement for graduation
- Hours help a student receive a Service Learning Cord (worn at graduation) and certain Seals for the Diploma.
- Service Learning Cord
 - Required min. of 40 hours of service over 4 years in any service learning category
- Seals for Diploma
 - Seal for Excellence in Civic Education (Social Studies)
 - STEM Seal (CTE)
 - Seal for Excellence in Science and Environment (Science)



Types Community Service

- Civics Education (Social Studies) Complete 50 hours of voluntary participation in community service or extracurricular activities, such as volunteering for a charitable or religious organization that provides services to the poor, sick or less fortunate; participating in Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts or similar youth organizations; participating in Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC); participating in political campaigns, government internships, Boys State, Girls State or Model General Assembly.
- Science & Environmental (Science) Complete at least 50 hours of voluntary participation in community service or extracurricular activities that involve the application of science such as environmental monitoring, protection, management, or restoration.
- Science, Technology, Engineering, & Math (CTE) Complete a 50-hour or more work-based learning opportunity in a STEM area, and satisfy all requirements for a Career and Technical Education concentration

Students who record and are approved for 40 hours in any category receive a Service Learning Cord to wear at graduation.

Students who record and are approved for 50+ hours in the category-specific area (Civic, Science, CTE) will receive a diploma seal in addition to the Service Learning Cord.
